

SENIOR THESIS APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Students must submit a completed senior thesis application to the Undergraduate Administrative Assistant in the Political Science Department by 4:30pm April 1st. The application must be supported by a tenured or tenure-track faculty member in the Political Science Department who agrees to serve as the student's advisor on the thesis. A completed application consists of the Thesis Cover Form (signed by your thesis advisor) and the Thesis Proposal (also signed by your thesis advisor). Students will be informed whether they are accepted into the thesis program by the end of the semester.

Your thesis proposal should describe your project in about 1500 words (5 pages) or less. You should provide your advisor a copy of the proposal at least two weeks before April 1st for his/her approval.

In your proposal, you should do the following:

1. Identify your research puzzle/problem/question;
2. Describe the importance of the puzzle/problem/question;
3. Relate briefly your work's contribution to the academic literature;
4. Briefly explain your argument;
5. Describe briefly your choice of method (e.g., case study, observational study, and experiment; conceptual analysis, textual interpretation, and normative argument).
6. Defend your ability to execute the thesis (e.g., data availability, methodological training, language expertise)
